When her song "A squash and a squeeze" was turned into a book, illustrated by Axel Scheffler, she decided to write professionally plays and books for children. Up to now, she has written 154 books, partly for retail sales and partly for school purposes. (DONALDSON, a) The German Axel Scheffler, now living in London, was born in 1957 and studied Arts History as well as Graphic Arts. At the beginning of his

career as illustrator, he worked for magazines and advertising agencies. Today, he mainly illustrates children's books.
