Consensus Over Switching Network Topology: Characterizing System Parameters and Joint Connectivity - Jiahu Qin 2021-10-27

The primary goal is to explicitly characterize how agent parameters, which reflect both self-dynamics and inner coupling of each agent, and switching network topologies jointly influence the collective behaviors. Chapter 2 addresses the consensus problem of double integrators over directed switching network topologies. How agent parameters and joint connectivity work together for reaching consensus is characterized from an algebraic and geometric view. Chapter 5 extends the design and analysis methodology to containment control problem, where there exist multiple leaders. A novel analysis framework from the perspective of state transition matrix is developed. This framework relates containment to consensus and overcomes the difficulty of construction of a containment error. This book serves as a reference to the main research issues and results on consensus of multi-agent systems. It was published on 8 June 1949 by Secker & Warburg as Orwell's ninth and final book completed in his lifetime. Orwell, himself a democratic socialist, modelled the authoritarian government in the novel after Stalinist Russia. The protagonist, Winston Smith, is a diligent and skillful rank-and-file worker and Outer Party member who secretly hates the Party and dreams of rebellion. He enters into a forbidden relationship with a colleague, Julia, and starts to remember what life was like before the Party came to power.
